INDEPENDENT ASSURANCE PRACTITIONER'S REVIEW REPORT

To the Members of the SeniorNet Kapiti Inc.

Report on the Performance Report:

I have reviewed the accompanying performance report of SeniorNet Kapiti Inc., which comprise the entity information, the statement of service performance, the statement of financial performance and the statement of cash flows for the year ended 31 March, 2020, the statement of financial position as at 31 March, 2020, and the statement of accounting policies and other explanatory information.

A review of the annual performance report in accordance with NZ SRE 2410 is a limited assurance engagement. I will perform procedures, primarily consisting of making enquiries, primarily of persons responsible for financial and accounting matters, and applying analytical procedures, and other review procedures.
